Order Suspending In-Person General Sessions Criminal Court Proceedings


Due to the surge in positive Covid-19 cases in Shelby County Tennessee the General Sessions Criminal Courts are reverting to operating under the guidelines of the Original Tennessee Supreme Court Order filed January 15, 2021 Suspending In-Person Proceedings.

1. This Order is effective January 15, 2021 through March 31, 2021.
2. The Private Defense Bar and the Shelby County Public Defender's office are to use all reasonable means available to inform their existing clients of these changes.
3. The Courts expect all pending cases to continue to be negotiated between the Defense Bar and the Shelby County Attorney General's office so as to expedite final dispositions of those cases when operations resume March 31, 2021.
4. Orders of Protection for In and Out of Custody defendants will continue as scheduled.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED this 19th day of January, 2021.




